He lives in a plush, riverside Apartment with modern Art splashed over the living room wall and a spanking new sports car perched in the basement garage. **I bet he's a 30 something IT consultant with a big ego and a bank balance to match. Or maybe he's an up and coming footballer.**

She owns a Victorian terrace overlooking a bunch of trees, smothered inside with pink sofas, cushions and pillows, mirrors everywhere you look, two cats, one black the other white and a yellow Mini shining outside. **All tell-tale signs she's probably a 20 something hairdresser desperate for love. Or possibly an eccentric millionaire?**

Our homes and what we fill them with speak volumes about who we are. But could the messages they give off attract our perfect partner? Or send them running?

In this new relationship show for ITV, **Date Me And My House**, serial love hunters choose their dates by looking around people's houses and deciding whether to date them based on what's on the inside as well as what's on the outside.

Our presenter takes romantic hopefuls around three houses, analyzing the colour of the walls and what hangs on them, pets, music and book collections, the contents of cupboards and drawers, furniture and everything else that makes up somebody's home.

Each programme focuses on a male and female's quest for love. We meet them in their own homes first, looking around and finding out about them, as well as the kind of person they'd like to meet, before our presenter shows them a list of prospective houses to mull over. Will the plastic surgeon from London be tempted to date the owner of the immaculate country cottage?

Having selected the houses they want to view, our presenter, someone like **Rebecca Loos** or **Jayne Middlemiss** leads them into the limousine as they speed off to their first appointment. Every step of the way, our hopefuls are building up a love profile of their

prospective dates. They'll open fridges, speculate over their wardrobe selection, listen to music and scrutinize the contents of dvd collections.

After viewing all of the three properties, they discuss the homes over a drink in a bar, try to guess the sort of people who live in them and finally choose the one they want to date.

Then our presenter leads them back to the properties to come face to face with the two people they've rejected. When the doors open...will they be shocked or relieved?
After finding out whether their guess was spot on or not, it's time to visit the home of the person they've chosen.

After another sizing-up moment based on their findings in the house, the door opens and their date invites them in. Where they'll stay for the weekend and get to know the house and owner a little better. But will they get a more personal tour of the bedroom or be left out in the cold on the sofa with not even a cat for company? We'll find out in **Date Me And My House**.
